Flagstaff:

Magistrate Judge Mark E. Aspey's courtroom is outfitted with an evidence presentation system/equipment. Please call Judge Aspey's office, Mr. Lalley or Ms. De La Paz for a demonstration.

Prescott:

The Prescott courtroom (2nd floor Courtroom ONLY) is outfitted with a portable presentation system (NOMAD PS-3000). All exhibits are viewed through a single LCD projector onto a single projector screen opposite the Jury box. There is NO equipment present in the basement hearing room in Prescott. Please call Mr. Lalley or Ms. De La Paz for a demonstration.

Yuma:

Magistrate Judge Jay R. Irwin's courtroom is outfitted with a portable presentation system (NOMAD PS-2000). Please call Judge Irwin's office, Mr. Lalley or Ms. De La Paz for a demonstration.

Phoenix / Exception:

Magistrate Judge Edward C. Voss' courtroom is outfitted with an integrated evidence presentation system. The presentation system is similar to the District Judge courtrooms. However, there is no gallery / plasma display monitor. Please call Judge Voss' office or Mr. Lalley for a demonstration.
