This General Order hereby amends and supersedes GENERAL ORDER 98-30.

With the approval of the Court,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that General Order 98-30 is hereby rescinded. Petitions for violation of probation, violation of supervised release or violation of pretrial release conditions will be filed with the Court. The supporting documents in the violation packet will not be made a part of the file, but will be returned to the Probation Office or Pretrial Services Office.

The Probation Office will retain the original copies of probation and supervised release violation packets on behalf of the Clerk of the Court. The Pretrial Services Office will retain original copies of pretrial services violation packets on behalf of the Clerk of the Court. When a request is made to the Clerk's Office to view such material, the request will be referred to either the Probation Office or Pretrial Services Office.

If the Probation Office or Pretrial Services Office believes it is necessary that a revocation petition be sealed, the filer shall motion the Court to seal the petition. Unless otherwise ordered, such

1 seal will be automatically vacated upon the return of the warrant by the U.S. Marshal.
