































District Judge Average Time-in-Court




#### District Judge Average Time-in-Court by Division




#### Magistrate Judge Time-in-Court by Division








#### Magistrate Judge Average Time-in-Court by Division





**District Misdemeanor Dispositions** 




### **Division Misdemeanor Dispositions**




### **District Supervision Caseload**






