On December 20, 2012, this Court issued a scheduling order for completing briefing of the dispositive crossmotions filed by the parties in this case. The Plaintiffs' Response/Reply has been filed, and Defendants' Reply shall be filed no later than February 11, 2013.

The Court has reviewed the motion related briefs, which in some instances have been filed in duplicate and in excess of the 17 page limit for motions. LR Civ. 7.1(e). In light of this extensive briefing and Judge Jorgenson's decision that a ruling on the

5 **IT IS ORDERED** that the Motions for Order to Show Cause (Doc. 18 (CV 12-
6 208 TUC DCB) and Doc. 3 (12-781 TUC DCB)) are DENIED.

7 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that duplicate filings are stricken as follows: Docs.
8 39; 29, and 30.

9 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Plaintiffs are granted leave to file in excess of
10 the page limit the combined Response to the Motion to Dismiss and Crossmotion for
11 Partial Summary Judgment (Doc. 25).

12 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Request for Leave of the Court to Allow
13 Non-electronic Filing (Doc. 37) is GRANTED. The Plaintiffs may provide the five discs
14 containing video evidence to the Clerk of the Court and a copy to Defendants.

15 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that pending the filing of the Defendants' Reply,
16 the dispositive motions are considered fully briefed and ready for disposition. There shall
17 be no further briefing related to the merits of the case, pending the Court's disposition of
18 the currently pending dispositive motions.
