GENERAL ORDER 06-03

To promote the prompt and consistent notification of victims and witnesses pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 3771, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

The Victim Witness Units for the United States Attorney's Office for the District of Arizona shall be granted an exemption from the requirements of Local Rule Civil 5.5(d) and shall be permitted to become Registered Users of the ECF system, subject to the following:

- The Clerk of the District Court is authorized to issue up to one Registered User Account to each Division of the United States Attorney's Office for the District of Arizona.
- The Accounts shall be used by the United States Attorney's Office for purpose of tracking Victim-related cases.
- Users of these authorized accounts are prohibited from using the Accounts to file electronically in any case.
