


1 entries and will be unavailable for viewing by the public or opposing counsel.

2 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that CJA vouchers be submitted within 45 days after a defendant
3 is sentenced or a case is dismissed. In cases where a substitution of counsel occurred, payment for a
4 claimant's services will not be delayed based on another attorney's untimely submission of a voucher.
5 Attorneys involved in a substitution who do not submit a voucher within 45 days after the conclusion
6 of the case as to the represented defendant may be subject to a reduction in payment if the total
7 compensation for the representation exceeds the statutory maximum and the overdue voucher is
8 unavailable for just apportionment.

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of Court is authorized to reject any CJA voucher that
10 does not comply with the automated Excel spreadsheet and electronic submission requirements addressed
11 herein.
