GENERAL ORDER 10-07

In accordance with the authority conferred by 28 U.S.C. § 631, pursuant to which provision prior joint consent and approval was given therefore by the United States District Judges for the Districts of Arizona and the Central and Southern Districts of California, and upon further action and authority granted by the Judicial Conference of the United States at its session September 24-25, 1981,


**IT IS ORDERED** that any duly appointed United States Magistrate Judge having authority at Yuma, Arizona shall be, and hereby is empowered, authorized, and appointed to exercise the same jurisdiction in the Central and Southern Districts of California as he is empowered and authorized to exercise within the District of Arizona however, subject to and conditioned upon the entry of a corresponding order to the same effect by the United States District Courts for the Central and Southern Districts of California. In addition, the United States Magistrate Judge officially having authority at El Centro, California shall be, and hereby is empowered, authorized, and appointed to exercise the same jurisdiction in the

1 District of Arizona as he is empowered and authorized in the Southern District of California.  
2 This authorization shall include those duties defined by 28 U.S.C. §636, and as set forth by  
3 any local rules pertaining to United States Magistrate Judges.

4 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that such exercise of jurisdiction and powers shall be  
5 immediately effective upon entry of a corresponding and concurring order to the same effect  
6 by the United States District Courts in the Central and Southern Districts of California, and  
7 the receipt and filing of a certified copy thereof as of record by the Clerk of this Court.

8 The Clerk shall forward certified copies of this order to: (1) the Clerks of the United  
9 States District Court, Central District of California and Southern District of California; (2)  
10 Honorable Audrey B. Collins, Chief Judge of the United States District Court, Central  
11 District of California; (3) , Irma E. Gonzalez, Chief Judge of the United States District  
12 Court, Southern District of California; (4) Jay R. Irwin, United States Magistrate Judge,  
13 Yuma, Arizona; (5) James Metcalf, Part-time United States Magistrate Judge, Yuma,  
14 Arizona; (6) Peter Lewis, United States Magistrate Judge, El Centro, California; and (7) the  
15 Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts.
