IT IS ORDERED, in accordance with Section 230.13 of *The Judiciary Guidelines* for Administering the CJA and Related Statutes, all Criminal Justice Act ("CJA") vouchers shall be submitted no later than 45 days after the defendant is sentenced or the case is otherwise disposed of in district court. Any voucher submitted beyond 45 days and less than one year after a defendant is sentenced or the case is otherwise disposed of in district court must be accompanied by a letter demonstrating good cause why the voucher should be paid. The Court may reject any voucher that lacks good cause for being submitted late. Unless otherwise ordered by the Court, the Clerk is directed to reject any CJA voucher submitted one year or more after the defendant is sentenced or the case is otherwise disposed of in district court.
