GENERAL ORDER 16-16

In accordance with the authority conferred by Title 28 U.S.C. Section 631, et. seq., and the further authority granted and action taken by the Judicial Conference of the United States,

IT IS ORDERED that Bernardo P. Velasco is reappointed as a full-time United States Magistrate Judge for the District of Arizona, at an annual salary as fixed by the Judicial Conference of the United States, with his official duty station being Tucson, Arizona.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Bernardo P. Velasco shall enter upon the performance of his duties at 12:01 a.m., on September 29, 2016, but prior to the commencement of such duties shall take the oath prescribed by Title 28 U.S.C. Sections 453 and 631(g).

Said full-time United States Magistrate Judge shall hold and discharge the duties of his office for a term of eight (8) years from the date of his reappointment subject to the provisions of Title 28 U.S.C. Section 631(c), unless sooner removed.
