GENERAL ORDER 19-07

14           Pursuant to applicable regulations of the Judicial Conference of the United States,  
15       Volume 3, Chapter 4 of the *Guide To Judiciary Policy*, regarding the Selection,  
16       Appointment, and Reappointment of United States Magistrate Judges, the majority of the  
17       judges of this Court hereby appoint on this date, seven members of a Merit Selection Panel,  
18       who shall review the current service of James F. Metcalf as United States Magistrate Judge  
19       in Yuma, Arizona, and consider comments from members of the bar and public; and other  
20       evidence of the incumbent's good character, judgment, legal ability, temperament, and  
21       commitment to equal justice under the law. The panel shall report to the Court within  
22       ninety (90) days from the date of this Order whether the incumbent is recommended for  
23       reappointment when his term expires on November 20, 2019.


