GENERAL ORDER 20-25

This General Order is being issued in response to the increase in northern Arizona, of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19).

General Order 20-16, entered on March 23, 2020, ordered a temporary closure of the Flagstaff Courthouse through April 10, 2020, except for those court proceedings, such as initial appearances, deemed necessary by the Court. General Order 20-19, entered on April 10, 2020, extended the temporary closure of the Flagstaff Courthouse through May 3, 2020.

Community transmission of COVID-19 continues to increase in northern Arizona, therefore IT IS ORDERED the temporary closure of the Flagstaff Courthouse is extended through May 29, 2020. All other aspects of General Order 20-16 shall remain in effect.
