

Notice to Court Reporter

In order to facilitate the creation of an accurate real-time record for Judge Silver, and counsel if requested, counsel shall provide a "Notice to Court Reporter" one week before any oral argument, hearing, or trial containing the following information that may be used during the oral argument, hearing, or trial:

1. Proper names, including those of witnesses.
2. Acronyms.
3. Geographic locations.
4. Technical (including medical) terms, names or jargon.
5. Table of authorities, in alphabetical order, which includes all of the authorities on which the parties will rely at said oral argument, hearing, and/or trial.

This Notice to Court Reporter need not be filed but shall be provided in person or via email to Judge Silver's Court Reporter: Elaine Cropper, 401 West Washington Street, Suite 312, P.O. Box 35, Phoenix, Arizona 85003-2150, ecropper@cox.net.

Counsel will advise Judge Silver's Court Reporter if counsel would like to receive a real-time (LiveNote, Summation, Bridge, any other real-time software) feed during any of the proceedings as soon as possible so that the proper paperwork may be in place and arrangements made for a test run before the actual proceeding.
