Security Reminders

All individuals entering a federal courthouse must show a government-issued photo ID and must pass through a security screening. Acceptable forms of identification include official state or United States government issued identification such as a driver's license or passport. This requirement is usually waived for those under the age of eighteen. You should arrive at least 15 minutes early for your scheduled tour. This will allow for ample time to walk through the security check point. Weapons, pocket-knives, scissors, sharp objects, mace, etc. are not allowed in the courthouse.

Appropriate Attire

Your attire should reflect the dignity of the courtroom. Please do not wear shorts, sweats, hats or t-shirts with printed statements. Since the courtrooms tend to be cool, you may also want to bring a sweater or light jacket.
