violation of probation, violation of supervised release or violation of pretrial release conditions, 17 and the issuance of arrest warrants thereto will be filed under seal and not disclosed to defense 18 counsel or the public without order of the Court, or until the U.S. Marshal returns the executed 19 warrant for filing. In addition, any Notice of Substitution of Counsel or a Notice of Appearance 20submitted by the United States in such cases may be filed under a temporary (T-Seal) seal. Upon 21 the U.S. Marshal's return of the executed warrant for filing, the Clerk shall unseal the petition, 22 any notices of substitution or appearance by the United States, and entry of the issuance of the 23 warrant, unless otherwise ordered by the Court. 24

The supporting documents in the violation packet will not be made part of the file, but will be returned to the Probation Office or Pretrial Services Office. The Probation Office will retain copies of probation and supervised release packets on behalf of the Clerk of Court. The Pretrial Services Office will retain original copies of pretrial services violation packets on behalf of the

1	Clerk of Court. When a request is made to the Clerk's Office to view such material, the request	
2	will be referred to either the Probation Office or the Pretrial Services Office, as appropriate.
