14	those unable to pay for these services, and
15	WHEREAS that Local Rule 83.1(a) of the Rules of Practice for the United States
16 17	District Court, District of Arizona, (Local Rules) provides for admission and continued
18	membership in the Federal Bar for attorneys who are active members in good standing of
19	the State Bar for Arizona, and
20	WHEREAS, the Arizona Supreme Court has authorized, pursuant to specific
21	provisions set out in Ariz. Sp. Ct. R. 38(f), Legal Service attorneys to practice in Arizona
22	
23	without complying with the examination requirement for admission to the Arizona State
24	Bar, if they are employed by approved legal service organizations in this State, and

WHEREAS, the State Bar of Arizona excepts Legal Service attorneys, employed by approved legal service organizations, from the examination requirement for admission to the State Bar and admits such Legal Service attorneys to practice under Ariz. Sp. Ct. R. 38(f) as active members in good standing to the State Bar of Arizona, and

WHEREAS, such authorization is limited exclusively to providing legal services to clients of the organization, the attorney may not be compensated except as an employee of the organization, admission expires if the attorney leaves the organization, and the attorney must comply with continuing legal education requirements.

IT IS ORDERED that this Court's reciprocal admission policy as expressed in Local Rule 83.1(a), extends to Legal Service attorneys admitted to practice in Arizona pursuant to Ariz. Sp. Ct. R. 38(f), and membership in the bar of this Court shall be equally limited and terminated. In all other regards these attorneys shall be treated the same as any other attorney admitted to practice before this Court.
