Unless otherwise ordered by a district judge, IT IS ORDERED that when a defendant who is under a term of federal supervision for illegal reentry after deportation, an alien smuggling offense, or a drug trafficking offense pleads guilty to a new crime of felony illegal reentry after deportation under 8 U.S.C. § 1326, and the plea agreement recommends the unsuccessful termination of supervision, the judge to whom the new crime is assigned for sentencing will also decide the request for unsuccessful termination of supervision. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that counsel for the defendant appearing on the new crime is authorized to represent the defendant on the unsuccessful termination of supervision, which will be heard at the time of sentencing on the new crime. The Clerk's minutes resulting from this proceeding are to be filed in both dockets.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all other new crimes where a defendant is on supervised release shall continue to be assigned as provided in the Court's Local Rule of Criminal Procedure 5.1(a).
