GENERAL ORDER 22-07

Pursuant to applicable regulations of the Judicial Conference of the United States, Volume 3, Chapter 4 of the *Guide To Judiciary Policy*, regarding the Selection, Appointment, and Reappointment of United States Magistrate Judges, the majority of the judges of this Court hereby appoint on this date, eight members of a Merit Selection Panel, who shall review the current service of John Z. Boyle as United States Magistrate Judge in Phoenix, Arizona, and consider comments from members of the bar and public; and other evidence of the incumbent's good character, judgment, legal ability, temperament, and commitment to equal justice under the law. The panel shall report to the Court within ninety (90) days from January 31, 2022, whether the incumbent is recommended for reappointment when his term expires on September 9, 2022.

The eight members of the Merit Selection Panel so appointed are as follows:

- Holly R. Geiszl –Lawyer


