- Lance Wilson – Non-Lawyer


**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** the Committee will recommend no less than six of the most qualified applicants to the Court within ninety (90) days of the appointment of the

4 All panel members have been advised in writing of the restriction set forth in  
5 420.30.20(d) of the Regulation of the Judicial Conference of the United States Establishing  
6 Standards and Procedures for the Appointment and Reappointment of United States  
7 Magistrate Judges.
