14	The United States District Court for the District of Arizona and the Arizona		
15	Department of Corrections, Rehabilitation & Reentry (ADCRR) began a prison electronic		
16	filing (e-filing) pilot project on May 1, 2012, for a period of one year. ¹ The pilot project		
17	was intended to increase the efficiency and reduce the cost of processing prisoner filings.		
18	The pilot project was extended and expanded to a second ADCRR Complex in August		
19	2014. ²		
20	The Court and ADCRR have agreed to make permanent the existing pilot program		
21	and expand it to include the following ADCRR Complexes and Private Facilities: Douglas		
22	Complex; Eyman Complex; Lewis Complex; Perryville Complex; Phoenix Complex;		
23	Safford Complex; Tucson Complex; Winslow Complex; Yuma Complex; Central Arizona		
24	Correctional Facility; Florence West; Kingman; La Palma; Marana; Phoenix West; and

Red Rock Correctional Center. Its use is mandatory for all unsealed cases filed in the District of Arizona.³

ADCRR must give at least fourteen (14) days' notice to the Court and to prisoners before beginning e-filing in any of the additional complexes listed in this General Order. This will provide the Court sufficient time to make necessary adjustments to its Electronic Case Filing system and inform prisoners about the transition to mandatory e-filing.

ADCRR will provide scanning equipment for use in each complex or facility. Each
complex or facility's staff will scan to PDF and, after quality review, email to the Court all
documents presented by prisoners for filing with the Court. The original documents will
be returned to the prisoner. All documents submitted for filing by prisoners must be
emailed to the Court in a PDF format.

12 The Court will receive and file the prisoners' documents electronically. After 13 service of the prisoner's complaint or petition and appearance by an opposing party, transmission of the Notice of Electronic Filing (NEF) to opposing parties who are 14 Electronic Case Filing Registered Users constitutes service of the hyperlinked document 15 16 for purposes of Rule 5(b)(2)(E) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure. The Clerk of 17 Court will mail a copy of the prisoner's electronically filed document(s) to Nonregistered 18 ECF Users. Prisoners filing under this Program are not required to submit courtesy copies 19 to the Court pursuant to Local Rule of Civil Procedure 5.4.

Each ADCRR Complex Unit must establish an email address for receipt of NEFs for documents filed electronically. Prison staff in each unit will print the NEFs, hyperlinked orders, and other documents filed by the Court. Receipt by the prisoner of copies of the NEFs, hyperlinked orders, and other hyperlinked documents constitutes service of the document on the prisoner. If the prisoner refuses delivery or is not currently at the designated Complex Unit, staff will indicate the reason for non-delivery on the NEF and email it to the Court for notation on the docket.

1	Opposing parties must serve filings on prisoners in ADCRR by means other than	
2	electronic filing as provided in Rule 5 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure. Prison staff	
3	will not provide to prisoners NEFs or the hyperlinked documents filed by opposing parties.	
4	These procedures shall take effect immediately for any case filed in any existing e-	
5	filing Complex Unit. These procedures shall take effect November 6, 2023, for any case	
6	filed in any new e-filing Complex Unit so long as the requisite advance notice has been	
7	provided to the Court and to that Complex Unit's prisoners.	
8	The Court and ADCRR must periodically evaluate the program and determine	
9	whether it should be continued, terminated, modified, or expanded.	
10	This General Order supersedes General Order 14-17.
