
The Court has determined the following general orders to be no longer necessary, and the Clerk is directed to remove them from the index of active General Orders of this Court:

24-15	U.S. Magistrate Judge Jacqueline Rateau was reappointed for an 8-year term, therefore, the merit selection panel that considered her reappointment is no longer necessary.
24-13	One new U.S. Magistrate Judge was appointed for an 8-year term in the Tucson Division, therefore, the extension of time for the merit selection panel that considered these applications has expired.
24-10	One new U.S. Magistrate Judge was appointed for an 8-year term in the Tucson Division, therefore, the merit selection panel that considered these applications is no longer necessary.

24-09	Guidelines have been adopted in the CJA Plan, at General Order 25-04.
23-18	The consolidation of the U.S. Probation Office and U.S. Pretrial Services Office occurred on April 18, 2024, pursuant to General Order 24-06.
