- Megan Page, Chief Assistant, Pima County Public Defender, Appointed

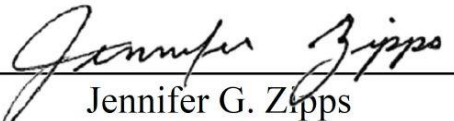
