## Standard Questions for Judge Tuchi's Jury Prescreening Questionnaire Civil Cases [Updated 4/24/2024]

Attached are the format and standard questions Judge Tuchi uses in preparing a prescreening questionnaire sent out to potential jurors for civil trials in his court.

- Yellow highlighted text are areas the Court will fill in prior to distribution.
- **The questions in a different font** will only be used in a civil trial involving a prisoner-filed civil case.
- When Judge Tuchi requests parties to submit proposed questions for a specific trial, **just submit any additional or case specific questions**. Do not duplicate questions already in the prescreening questionnaire.
- If you have objections to any questions in the form, include the objections at the end of your submission indicating the number, the question and the issue.
