Notice to Court Reporter

In order to facilitate the creation of a more accurate real-time record for Judge Tuchi, and counsel if requested, and pursuant to Judge Tuchi's standing order, counsel shall provide a "Notice to Court Reporter" no less than one week prior to any oral argument, hearing, or trial containing the following information that may be used during the oral argument, hearing, or trial:

- 1. Proper names, including those of witnesses.
- 2. Acronyms.
- 3. Geographic locations.
- 4. Technical terms, names or jargon.

5. Table of authorities, in alphabetical order, which includes all of the authorities on which the parties will rely at said oral argument, hearing, and/or trial.

This Notice to Court Reporter need not be filed but shall be provided via email to Elaine Cropper, <u>Elaine Cropper@azd.uscourts.gov</u>. 602-322-7245.

Counsel will advise Judge Tuchi's Court Reporter if counsel would like to receive a real-time feed or daily turnaround transcript during any of the proceedings as soon as possible in order to ensure the proper paperwork is in place and arrangements made for a real-time test run **before** the actual proceeding. No real-time feed will be facilitated the day of trial.
