GUIDELINES FOR SUBMITTING PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE RULES OF PRACTICE OF THE UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT FOR THE DISTRICT OF ARIZONA

Proposed amendments to the Rules of Practice of the District of Arizona may be submitted by any person or organization pursuant to Local Rule of Civil Procedure 83.9 of the Local Rules of Practice. The rule provides for an annual amendment of the Court's Rules to become effective on December 1.

Form of Submission

No specific form or format for submitting a proposed amendment is required. However, a convenient <u>form-fillable cover sheet</u> is available to assist in the development and description of the proposed amendment.

Deadline for Submission

Generally, for a change to become effective on December 1, a proposal must be submitted to the district court's Rules Committee by August 31 of the preceding year.
