Step Up To Justice (SU2J) and the United States District Court for the District of Arizona in Tucson offer a FREE Advice-Only Clinic to the public. People will have the opportunity to speak one-on-one with an attorney about their federal civil case.

In order to attend the Federal Court Advice-Only Clinic you must be:

REPRESENTING YOURSELF (do NOT have an attorney)

AND

Involved in or considering filing a CIVIL FEDERAL case (a case arising under federal law OR a case in which both parties reside in different states and the amount in controversy is \$75,000 or more. The clinic cannot provide assistance in criminal cases.)

When: Clinic is held by appointment only; Thursdays from 1:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Eligibility: This clinic is open to anyone who doesn't have an attorney *and* has a current CIVIL federal court issue. There is no income level requirement.

IMPORTANT: In order to maximize your time with the attorney and to be respectful of others, please do not bring your children with you to your appointment.
