GENERAL ORDER 22-19

Pursuant to applicable regulations of the Judicial Conference of the United States, Volume 3, Chapter 4 of the *Guide To Judiciary Policy*, regarding the Selection, Appointment, and Reappointment of United States Magistrate Judges, the majority of the judges of this Court hereby appoint on this date, seven members of a Merit Selection Panel, who shall review the current service of Deborah M. Fine as United States Magistrate Judge in Phoenix, Arizona, and consider comments from members of the bar and public; and other evidence of the incumbent's good character, judgment, legal ability, temperament, and commitment to equal justice under the law. The panel shall report to the Court within ninety (90) days from the date of this Order whether the incumbent is recommended for reappointment when her term expires on May 3, 2023.


